Bogdan Mikhailov <b>Project #8 from CC manual: "Get Comfortable With Visual Aids"</b>  <i>Title: "Do you drink?"</i> <i>Time: 5 – 7 min</i></p>	<p><b>Objectives:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select visual aids that are appropriate for your message and the audience</li> <li>Use visual aids correctly with ease and confidence</li> </ul>

Victor Maevskiy <b>Project #2 from CC manual: "Organize Your Speech"</b>  <i>Title: "Can our virtual identities have real feelings?"</i> <i>Time: 5 – 7 min</i></p>	<p><b>Objectives:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select an appropriate outline which allows listeners to easily follow and understand your speech</li> <li>Make your message clear, with supporting material directly contributing to that message</li> <li>Use appropriate transitions when moving from one idea to another</li> <li>Create a strong opening and conclusion</li> </ul>

Maxim Luchinin  <b>Project #10 from CC manual: "Inspire Your Audience"</b></p> <p><i>Title: "Plunge into the underwater!"</i>  <i>Time: 8 – 10 min</i></p>	<p><b>Objectives:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To inspire the audience by appealing to noble motives and challenging the audience to achieve a higher level of beliefs or achievement</li> <li>• Appeal to the audience's needs and emotions, using stories, anecdotes and quotes to add drama</li> <li>• Avoid using notes</li> </ul>

Sergey Kuzin, ACS  <b>Project #4 from ACG manual: "Handling Challenging Situations"</b></p> <p><i>Title: "Who is eligible to represent the Club at the Qualification Contests?"</i>  <i>Time: 22 – 32 min</i></p>	<p><b>Objectives:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select a problem and ask club members to discuss and resolve it by either a majority vote or by compromise</li> <li>• Serve as facilitator for the discussion</li> <li>• Effectively handle any member's behavioral problems that may interfere with the discussion</li> </ul>
